### **Executive Director's Report**

- DHS activated a small team to screen incoming passengers at Dulles International Airport due to an outbreak of Ebola in the Democratic Republic of Congo and other surrounding areas effective March 5, 2021.
  - Chuck Kramaric and Geoff Davis are the Operations Co-Managers
  - Dawn McKenna is the Assistant Operations Manager and handles all IAD staffing
  - There are 11 leads and 31 screeners hired and working
  - There are currently four shifts
    - 0730 – 1130 with 1 lead and 2 screeners
    - 1330 – 1830 at FIS with 1 screener
    - 1330 – 1730 with 1 lead and 2 screeners
    - 1730 – 2130 with 1 lead and 1 screener
  - Laura is handling all HR functions internally and is the liaison between the screeners/leads and Ambassador Accounting
  - Currently, the volume of incoming passengers being screened is low

- We have been contacted by George Mason University to assist with a COVID vaccine clinic to assist with the Fairfax County Health Department overflow

- Craig is working with Alan Stillman still on a Stroke Smart Community video to target community leaders and government agencies on becoming Stroke Smart Communities
- Craig is working on a separate training server through ESO for EMT and Paramedic classes to train on the EHR while in class
- Ashes2Art has created a Mindful Decon Kit to assist with continual individual stress management after each incident instead of cumulative stress

### JURISDICTIONAL REPORTS

#### City of Alexandria Fire Department

Deputy Chief of EMS Brian Hricik provided the following update:

- They have created significant changes due to the reorganization of their Battalion Management Teams consisting of one EMS Captain with a Battalion Chief on the east side of the city and a Battalion Chief and their aide on the west side
  - They recently did promotional interviews for EMS Lieutenant supervisors
  - Two new promotions last week will take effect April 3<sup>rd</sup>
    - Amy Lusby and Dave Fox were promoted to EMS Lieutenant
    - There will be up to 10-12 more EMS Lieutenant promotions upcoming and they'll be using them as FTOs as needed as well
- Several employees in ALS class and internships right now so they'll have more ALS providers on the street soon
- They are working with Hospital Hub at Alexandria and Fairfax hospitals to connect billing with them
- Two new Braun ambulances are in but not yet registered as this is by appointment only at DMV
  - They are in the process of getting the mechanic shop to get Registration certified so they can do it internally in the future
  - They are moving away from the Terrastar chassis

#### Arlington County Fire Department

EMS Battalion Chief Anne Marsh provided the following update:

- They are currently doing promotional interviews due to many unexpected retirements and departures
  - There will be several Lieutenant candidates promoted
- They are working on ET3 component with CMS for telehealth and alternative destination transportation agreements
- They have APOs now in vehicles on A Platoon
- They are reinstating their ride-along program
  - They added a PPE requirement, waiver, and COVID requirements
- They recently accepted applications for eight ALS providers
- BLS transport is in service and going well with no issues with patient care identified
  - They have three in service as of today
- COVID Vaccination update
  - 86% of the staff has had their first vaccination
  - 83% has had their second
  - They are doing BLS standby at the vaccination clinic which has approximately 2000 residents per day coming through

- They opened a vaccine clinic at Stonebridge in Alexandria on March 29<sup>th</sup>
  - EMS has come a few times for adverse reactions
- They are working on CARES registry integration
- Inova Health System has reached out to CPI for de-escalation training
  - It will start in the EDs first, then to other units

## **NEW BUSINESS**

- Spring 2021 RSAF grading
  - We discussed previously, the RSAF grading for this round will be done via Google Forms. A Conflict of Interest/Confidentiality Statement has been mailed to everyone. Upon its return, the link to vote will be emailed to the primary voters. If the primary voter is not available, notify the Council of your alternate who will vote in your place
- Arlington County funding assistance request
  - Arlington County has 5-7 Educational Coordinator candidates in the pipeline and is requesting assistance from the Council for funding to send their candidates to the EC Institute in Lynchburg this June
    - The total cost for 7 candidates would be approximately \$4860.57
      - They have been informed they can utilize a County van which would reduce the cost by \$1379.84 as they will not need reimbursement for round-trip mileage
  - EMS DC Hricik from Alexandria Fire Department presented the following questions
    - Is this solely for Arlington County?
      - Craig advised it was
    - Have they exhausted all 4 For Life funds?
      - Chief Reshetar advised that is unknown at this time
    - Where does this end? Do we fund all agencies that need assistance? The Council should and can consider funding regional efforts, not single agencies.
      - Clare Sabio from Arlington County advised by completing the Institute, they can offer their classes to anyone in the region so it doesn't just benefit Arlington County, it benefits the region
      - Clare Sabio advised OEMS only holds an Institute when there a significant number of candidates in the state and the last was two years ago. There are 30 people in the pipeline now. The process takes a long time to be eligible and there are only two years to finish the requirements in the cycle

Board of Directors Minutes – April 1, 2021

- The last EC update, not Institute, was 3 years ago at Dulles Airport and was full of Regional ECs
- Is there a need for a regional EC class?
  - Adam Harrell from OEMS advised that to hold a regional EC Institute, they need at least 16 qualified candidates
  - There is currently a second Institute scheduled for later this year in Norfolk but there are not enough candidates to hold it at this point. There is a minimum of 16 and a maximum of 30 allowed
  - He reached out to the ACE division and was told they can hold an Institute in Northern Virginia in the next 6 months if we can secure the minimum number of 16 qualified registered and through the process
  - One challenge they have is with social distancing and trying to keep 6 feet distance around 33 people in one room.
    - Finding a venue is difficult due to this
  - The state will cover the fees to hold the Institute here if we can assist in finding a venue with acceptable distancing
  - Prince William County, Loudoun County, and Fairfax County advised they have staff also needing the EC Institute and we can likely reach the minimum of 16 candidates to hold it in our region
- Chief Hricik advised he'd be most comfortable with spending Council funds to pay for meals or a venue if needed to accomplish the EC Institute in our region
- Clare Sabio advised they could hold off until later this year, but not into 2022
- Adam Harrell advised we need to get a minimum of 16 in the certification pipeline now so the ACE division can see them and get our Institute on the books in the next 6-8 months
  - To clarify, this means candidates need to apply to be an EC, have been assigned a mentor and have completed their hours, and are ready for the institute

- Arlington County withdrew its request for funding and a motion was made to move forward with OEMS sponsoring a Northern Virginia EC Institute in the future
  - The motion was acknowledged by Chief Hricik and seconded by Beth Adams
    - The motion was unanimously accepted
