  - Kate was approached by the NP for the Archdiocese of Washington Schools about the consideration of cooling before transport
  - Their Athletic Trainers just had training on this topic and the NP may be able to come in and

- Removal of pads in spinally compromised patients during athletic events for consideration at the Trauma PI Meeting
- Craig French said he may be able to get people from the CVICU to present cases of cardiac arrest with ROSC and the many layers of treatment and rehab following those events
- CARES Registry data
  - This could lead to public CPR and AED campaigns to get ideas for public engagement
- ER EDP and TDO, Marcus Law, etc.
  - Maybe have a CSB representative that can attend and give another presentation
  - Arlington may also be able to share with their telehealth as they've been at the forefront of that
